From the local community of Del Mar/Carmel Valley, **Chase Morrin, keyboardist/composer/band director sensation is only fifteen.** A Canyon Crest Academy sophomore, Morrin started playing piano after discovering a toy keyboard at age 8. By age 12, Morrin became the youngest recipient of the national American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers (**ASCAP**) **Young Jazz Composer** award presented to him at the Lincoln Center in New York. His awards include the Composers Today state awards from the Music Teachers Association of California (MTAC), the prestigious Herb Alpert Scholarship for Emerging Young Artist from the faculty of the California State Summer School for the Arts--InnerSpark, and numerous awards such as "outstanding soloist," "most talented," and "musician of the year" from various festivals and groups.
